36 holes stroke play. Tournament may be shortened due to inclement weather. Ties for 1st place will be decided by a sudden death playoff; remaining ties will be decided by a scorecard playoff per USGA guidelines, when necessary. 1st place will be decided by scorecard playoff if weather/light dictates.

All TJGT Hard Card Policies are in effect for this tournament.

TEES

Boys 11-14 & 15-18 Divisions: GOLD Tees

Girls 11-14 & 15-18 Divisions: GREEN Tees

LOCAL PLAYER NOTES

- The golf course will be played as it is marked. All tall grass areas, rocky areas and thick/unmaintained areas are part of the golf course, players must play the ball at is lies. Players are STRONGLY encouraged to hit provisional balls as much as possible/needed.
- The halfway house and gravel area right of No. 9 green is an immovable obstruction. Players are entitled to free relief if their stance or swing is interfered, but line-of-sight relief is not granted.
- All property fences, white stakes, parking lots, roads and back yards are out-of-bounds

PRACTICING ON GREENS PROHIBITED

Between the play of two holes, a player must not make any practice strokes on or near the putting green of the hole just completed or test the surface of that putting green by rubbing the putting green or rolling a ball. The penalty for doing so is 2 shots (general penalty) under Note 2 to Rule 7-2.

SPECTATOR/PLAYER INTERACTION

Players and spectators are not to have interaction during play. Patrons may assist in looking for a lost ball, but otherwise must stay on the cart path and/or far off the green during tournament play. Players are not to walk with spectators. If a spectator is observed walking with, talking to or giving advice (or appear to be) to a player, a player may be subject to a penalty or disqualification in accordance with the TJGT Spectator Policy.

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES

In accordance with USGA Rules of Golf, the Note under Rule 14-3 for all TJGT Events: Therefore, a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If a player uses a device that measures more than distance, the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional information function is actually used.
